

8.MS (Business Administration)

The primary objective of MS (Business Administration) program is to provide a unique opportunity to the graduates having 16 years of business education like BBA, BS (BA), BS (MIS), B.Com, BS (Accounting & Finance), 2 year old MBA etc. or equivalent business education to improve their academic qualification along with exposure of pragmatic academic research. More importantly, after earning the degree of MS (Business Administration) the graduates either may apply for higher studies (i.e. PhD) in national and foreign universities or they may apply for jobs in national and multination organizations.

Objectives of the program

Primary objective of this program is provide an opportunity to the students to understand the basics of theoretical and practical research. Moreover, to learn how practical research can be conducted to find the solution of various problems faced by individuals, firms and government.

Eligibility criteria: 16 years of business education or equivalent, or 4 years business education (minimum of 120 CRH) after HSSC/FA/FSC/Grade 12 or equivalent shall be required for admission in this program.

The applicant either have earned CGPA 2.50/4.00 or 2.80/5.00 in terminal degree under semester system

Admission Test: Passing marks will be 50% as notified by the university through Notification No. Acad/1-23/GEP/9881 Dated 18/09/2023.

Intra-Disciplinary Qualifications: The applicant has passed GRE-Subject/Equivalent Test i.e. GAT-subject/HAT Subject with minimum 50% marks in the discipline of admission and has taken 6-9 CRH of deficiency courses of Level 6.

The admission committee is satisfied that the applicant's knowledge of primary area has sufficiently prepared him/her to undertake the course studies of MS (Business Administration) or committee if deems necessary may opine to take a few more courses after starting the program.

Course Work Requirement: For the award of the degree a candidate shall complete minimum 30 credit hours of coursework OR 24 CRH of coursework along with 6 CRH of Research work/Thesis.

Program duration 2 Years

Semester 4 (1 Year course work and 1 Year research work)
